Important information for Camping and Caravans

Camping and caravans are not allowed at the circuit on the Friday night before a Sunday event. This is due to the airfield management requiring members of the Club to be on site at all times visitors are present. As most members of CMCC are working full-time it is not possible for us to be there on a Friday. The only exception will be the BRCA Electric two day meeting when racing starts on the Saturday.

When you arrive please do not set up tents or awnings etc before you have checked with Race control where to pitch. If you do not do this you may be asked to move to fit in with the campsite organisation. are required to organise the camping field in accordance with Airfield safety requirements.

For Sunday events the track will be open for practice on Saturday from 10.00am until 6.00pm. On the Sunday the track will be open from 8.00am.

Please help us by not leaving litter at the circuit or in the car parking and camping areas. Preferably take your rubbish home with you. Bin bags will be available from race control for this purpose.

Access to the Airfield

This is via an automatic gate which is locked at 7.00pm and opens again at 7.00am. After 7.00pm you will be able to exit the airfield by driving up to the gate which will then open. However, you will not be able to get back in unless you can get someone to come and open the gates for you.

Restricted use of Generators

To avoid the noise of generators conflicting with the circuit PA system this wooded area is the only place generators are allowed at the circuit. Please do not run a generator within the camping, caravanning or pitting areas. All fuel cans must be stored in the cage located in this area.
